SAFETY & HEALTH POLICY

At K.J. Precision Sdn Bhd, we are committed to maintaining a safe and healthy work environment for all employees, contractors, visitors, and the communities in which we operate. We recognize that the well-being of our employees is of utmost importance and strive to prevent workplace accidents, injuries, and occupational illnesses. This Safety and Health Policy outlines our commitment to providing a safe workplace and sets the foundation for our safety and health programs.

Compliance with Laws and Regulations

We are dedicated to complying with all applicable laws, regulations, and industry standards related to safety and health in our manufacturing operations. We will continually monitor and update our practices to align with any new or revised legal requirements.

Responsibility and Accountability

- 1. Management Commitment: The management team at KJPI is responsible for providing leadership and resources to ensure the effective implementation of safety and health programs. They are committed to fostering a culture of safety, where safety and health considerations are integrated into all business decisions.
- Employee Responsibility: Every employee is responsible for their own safety and the safety of their co-workers. It is our expectation that all employees comply with safety policies and procedures, report hazards and incidents, and actively participate in safety training and programs.

Risk Assessment and Hazard Control
